Aim of the scheme

- To Generate employment opportunity in Manufacturing (activity involving Machinery / Equipments) and Manufacturing related Service sector in Urban and Rural Areas
- Providing facility for consumers required products to be available in local area.
- Primary objective of the scheme is to Strengthen Micro enterprises financially.
- Per capita investment –Rs 300000/-

Applicant's eligibility

- Age – Min.18 years and above
- Qualification – Min. 8th std.pass (if Project cost exceeds Rs 10 Lakhs)
- Resident – Should be the Citizen of India

Basic Documents required to submit application in online

- Mobile phone number linked Aadar Card
- Pass port size photo
- TC/SSLC Marks card for Date of birth proof
- Population certificate of the village or town where the proposed project is going to implement issued by Local Development agency/ Dept.
- Proposed Activity's project report
- Caste certificate (Mandatory for Male candidates)

- ▶ Insurance policies
- ▶ IT Returns copy
- ▶ Skill training certificate

- ▶ No charges for online application submission
- ▶ No last date for submission of application
- ▶ No restriction for area in selecting Financing Bank Branch
- ▶ No restriction in selecting location of the proposed unit and Resident address of the applicant

Negative List of Activities

The following list of activities will not be permitted under PMEGP for setting up of micro enterprises/ projects / units

- 1. Any industry/business connected with Meat(slaughtered),i.e. processing, canning and/or serving items made of it as food, production/manufacturing or sale of intoxicant items like Beedi/Pan/ Cigar/Cigarette etc., any Hotel or Dhaba or sales outlet serving liquor, preparation/producing tobacco as raw materials, tapping of toddy for sale.**
- 1. Any industry/business connected with cultivation of crops/ plantation like Tea, Coffee, Rubber etc. sericulture (Cocoon rearing), Horticulture, Floriculture,, Piggery, Harvester machines etc.**
- 1. Manufacturing of Polythene carry bags of less than 20 microns thickness and manufacture of carry bags or containers made of recycled plastic for storing, carrying, dispensing or packaging of food stuff and any other item which causes environmental problems.**
- 1. Industries such as processing of Pashmina Wool and such other products like hand spinning and hand weaving, taking advantage of Khadi Programme under the purview of Certification Rules and availing sales rebate.**

Activities Permitted Under PMEGP Scheme

- Activities under Manufacturing / Service Sector Involving Machineries or Equipments
- New activities allowed with effective from 01.06.2022
 - a. Dairy, Poultry, Aquaculture, Beekeeping or Permitted
 - b. Transport activities -Transport activities viz purchase of Cab/van/ Boat/Motorboat/Shikara etc. for transportation of tourists or general public will be allowed. A ceiling of 10% on the extent of projects financed under transport activities is applicable in all areas
